(2) The 26th National Children's Science Congress:

The Children's Science Congress is a flagship program, supported and catalyzed by National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC), under the Department of Science and Technology (DST), Govt. of India and its counterpart MPCST, for spreading the concept of the method of science among the children of the age group 10 to 17 years, adopting the process of learning through doing.



The three days MP State level program of 26th NCSC was held in MPU from 2 to 4 December 2018, in which 250 Children Scientists, from all over MP, participated and presented their research papers and project models. Dr. A.K. Pandey, Chairman, MP Pvt. Universities Regulatory Commission inaugurated the meet on 2nd December 2018.
